Dr. Louis Jacobs is a world-famous scientist with a 50+-year career as a vertebrate paleontologist. His newest exhibit, "Sea Monsters Unearthed: Life in Angola's Ancient Seas," opened in November at the Smithsonian's National Museum of Natural History.

Dr. Bonnie Jacobs is a noted expert on paleobotany and the historic influence of climate on plant geography and leaf morphology, and she aims to understand past communities, ecosystems and climate from sediments 110 million to <1,000 years old. Her paleobotanical research in East Africa sheds light on the environmental context of human origins.
