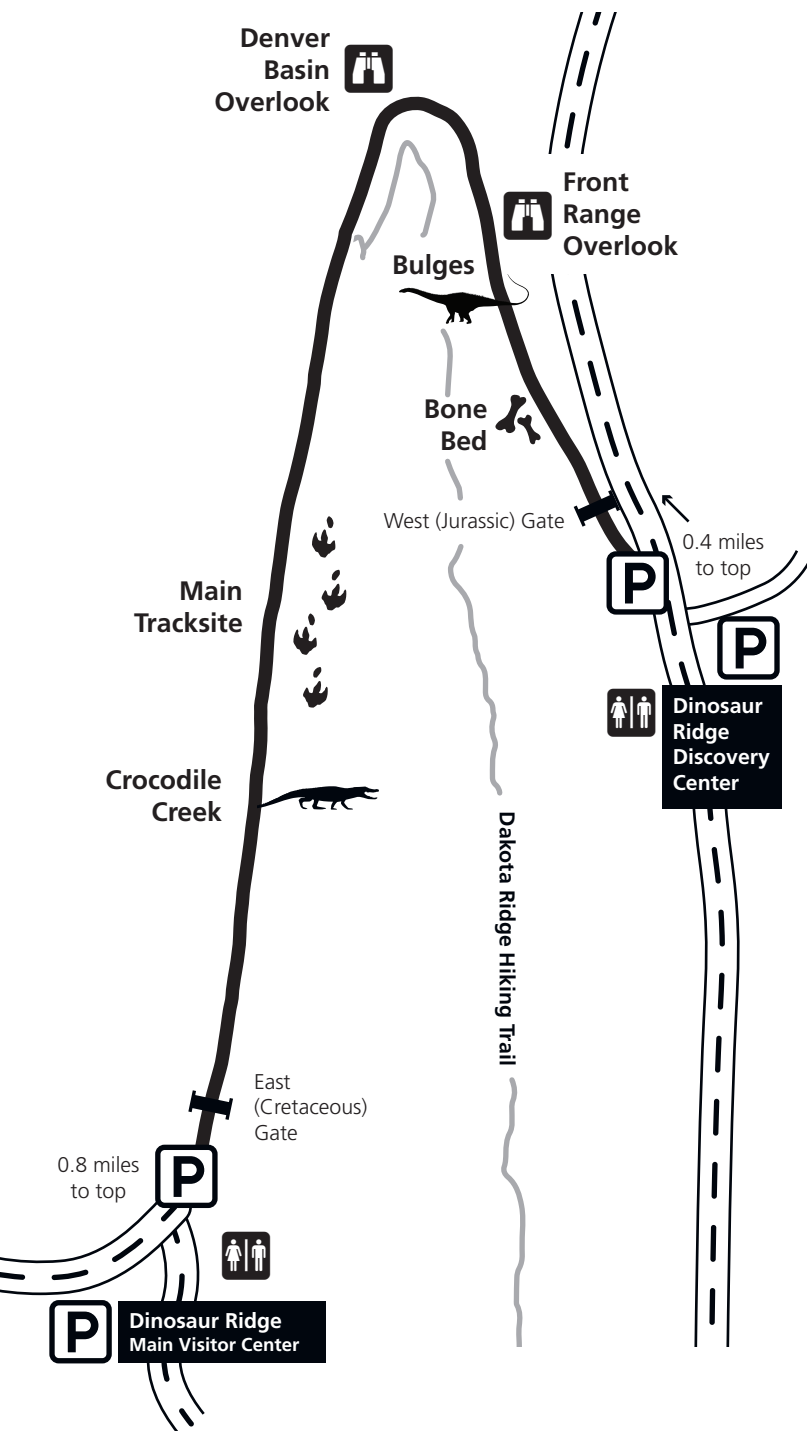


Dinosaur Ridge Tour Map

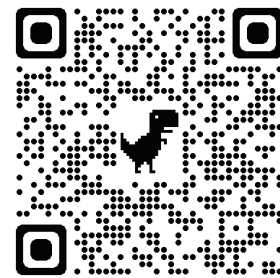


As you move along Dinosaur Ridge trail, you'll be looking at 100 - 150 million year old rock layers containing dinosaur and ancient crocodile tracks, fossils, and evidence of prehistoric environments that tell us about life and death in Colorado during Cretaceous and Jurassic times. There are more than a dozen scientifically significant stops along the way.

Note: the paved road is about 2.5 miles round-trip. Water, snacks, and bathroom facilities are available at our Visitor Center and Discovery Center on either side of the Ridge. No climbing or collecting rocks allowed.
